Another of Saint-Véran 187 lieux-dits ! The aroma intensity is subtle. Peach, pineapple, apple, white blossom and lemon peel. Lightly toasty with nutty notes and a dash of honey. Youthful. Dry. Rich, soft and voluptuous with intensity. Really incredible richness with also pear, melon, lemon peel, neroli and honeysuckle. Creamy with a lightly nutty oak spice, sesame and hazelnut. Medium bodied and a nice finish. An amazing palate.

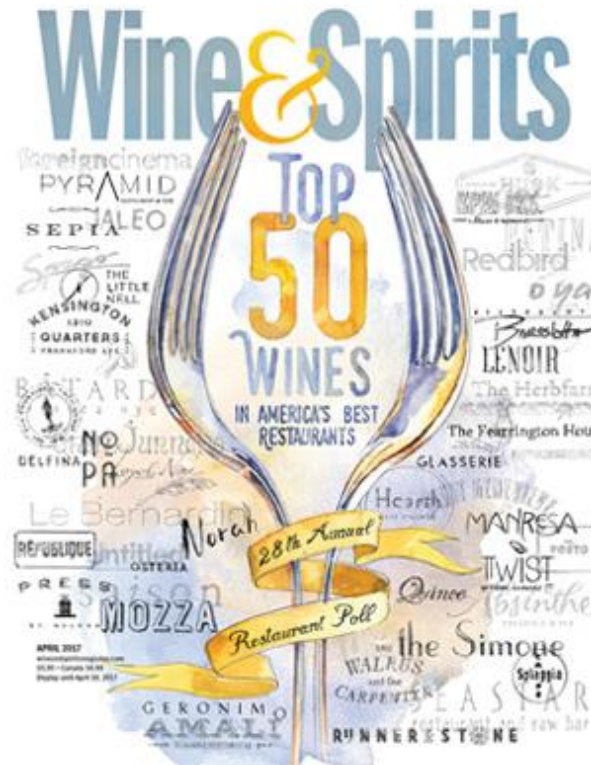
